HOW DOES THE SCHEME HELP LOCAL PEOPLE?

- Chance2shine provides a range of structured work placements for unemployed people with local employers to enable them to gain valuable new skills and rebuild their confidence to get them back on the road to full-time employment.
- Placements are part-time to enable the participants to continue to look for employment and they only last 4 weeks to ensure they move on into work after their placement and don't get 'stuck' in volunteering.
- If participants do a good job in their work placement we ask employers to commit to being a referee for them for future job applications as this is something really valuable that they will need to get paid work.

We pay for daily travel costs for placements and any work equipment or uniform that participants need to keep the costs as low as possible for people claiming benefits and we'll also pay for a DBS check if needed.
